Surrounds us with truck traffic on 3 sides. 816 new trucks per day on Route 145. 673 new trucks on Route 41. 55 new trucks on Avenue 12. On these 2-lane roads, impatient drivers will take risks to pass slow-moving trucks, increasing the risk of a head-on collision.



Hogs our water. 4,000 acre-feet flowing into the quarry pit, drawing down Ranchos wells. A series of toothless conditions won't even begin to fix the problem.



Hurts our local economy. The County gets a few new jobs and a few hundred thousand dollars in taxes. Our homes go down in value by 20%.
